It is the mission of this Foundation to help these women regain control of their lives as they create the future that brings them personal satisfaction and financial independence.

In addition to offering educational grants, periodically the Foundation offers personal development seminars to assist women in transition who are in the process of determining how to reach financial independence. Each woman selected to participate in the Reclaiming Success Program receives a Special Consideration Grant to cover the registration cost for the six (6) seminars and related mentoring.

#### **Self-Discovery Seminars**

This series of six (6) seminars will help participants:

- assess their personal and career priorities
- create their personal vision for the future
- develop a Personal Action Plan to achieve their life goals

Participants will be challenged to create specific action plans that build on their individual talents and will ultimately bring them personal satisfaction. Since it is the intent of the Foundation to facilitate self-discovery and independence, the seminars will include self-assessment and self-reflection tools, as well as group activities.

#### **Mentoring**

Each Reclaiming Success Program participant will also be assigned a mentor to help her explore her unique issues and concerns as she takes steps to develop and implement her Personal Action Plan. Mentoring will take place by telephone and via email.
